The individual will perform all I&E duties as experience permits. The primary duties will include providing I&E support to all departments with day-to-day maintenance and troubleshooting. This position will be on an on-call rotation if necessary. Further, the job may require the following tasks:

- Comply with all applicable DOT and OSHA regulations, and safety policies and procedures
- Performing installation, calibration, maintenance and troubleshooting of equipment
- Performing and providing technical support for installation, calibration, maintenance, and repairs of instrument and electrical equipment
- Performing planned maintenance checks and calibrations on a semi-annual schedule
- Maintaining current and accurate documentation of maintenance activities
- Minimizing downtime and unsafe conditions by performing preventative and predictive maintenance
- Initiating Management of Change requests for proposed changes to equipment, instrumentation and programs
- Pursuing cost reduction opportunities
- Be on call, responding to emergencies and maintain emergency response preparedness

The individual must have strong organizational skills; the ability to coordinate, prioritize, and execute many tasks at once; be self-motivated and have an ability to work well in adverse, out-door weather conditions including extreme heat and cold.

The candidate must have a valid driver's license and be insurable under the Company's vehicle insurance policy as well as pass a pre-employment drug screen. The employee will also be subject to drug testing in accordance to the Company's policies and procedures.

The employee must be able to regularly lift and move up to 10 pounds, frequently lift and move up to 25 pounds, and occasionally lift and move up to 50 pounds.
